

Club Funding Summer 2021 Transparency Report

As per section 5.1.16 of the Clubs Code all clubs approved for funding for the Summer 2021 Club Funding period are made publicly available on this document. Clubs that were denied club funding are not listed by name, however the number of clubs that were not approved is listed.

The approval process first started at Campus Vibe uOttawa. Zachary Flahaut, Liliya Molchanova and Hassan Ahmed from CVUO were responsible for the interim review, which involved sending early applications recommendations on making better applications and ensuring that all the fields were correctly filled. CVUO was also responsible for compiling the applications and presenting them to the UOSU Student Services Committee. No approval or rejection of applications was done by any of the CVUO members.

UOSU's Student Services Committee was responsible for conducting the final review of the application. The committee met several times over the course of September 2021 to discuss and decide on each application individually. The Student Services Committee members are as follows:

\$20000 were planned to be allocated to the summer funding but due to a large number of applications, the Student Services Committee voted to reallocate the money saved from the Winter 2021 semester to the Summer 2021 semester. A total of \$15000 were reallocated, \$5000 to each tier.
